White Wine

Marques Calado Macabeo

£12.50 per bottle £2.40 (125ml) £4.60 (250ml)

Cariñena DO, Spain

Fresh, floral aromas reminiscent of aromatic herbs such as anise and fennel, the smooth and velvety palate is fruit driven with citrus and banana characteristics.

Albinoni Garganega / Pinot Grigio

£13.00 per bottle £2.45 (125ml) £4.70 (250ml)

Veneto, Italy

Light in colour, refreshing and crisp, with aromas of limes, grapefruits and lemons making this well balanced wine very easy to drink.

Tin Roof Chardonnay

£14.00 per bottle £2.55 (125ml) £4.85 (250ml)

South Eastern, Australia

A soft buttery Chardonnay, with a smooth mouthfeel and a rich fruity finish. Whilst this wine makes an excellent companion to most types of food it is mellow enough to also be enjoyed on its own.

Fairhall Cliffs Sauvignon Blanc

£15.00 per bottle £2.70 (125ml) £5.10 (250ml)

Marlborough, New Zealand

Very zesty on the palate with lots of lime and a nettley herbaceousness. This is an aromatic and classic New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc with a refreshing dry finish.

Frascati Superiore, Cantina San Marco

Italy

The scent of fresh green apples and ripe white grapes, enhanced with distinctly floral tones. Light in feel, but with good concentration on the palate and a balance between soft fruit and snappy acidity.

La Grille Cool-Fermented Chenin Blanc, Gwenaël Guihard

Loire Valley, France

A freshly fruity and slightly off-dry white. Bottled with a natural spritz to maintain freshness. Plenty of white flower and peach characters contribute to the balance of this wine

Macon Villages Blanc, Cave de Lugny

£18.50 per bottle

Burgundy, France

A great wine from one of Burgundy's most reliable and well-reputed producers. This wine is crisp and elegant showing citrus, apple and pear fruit characters. It has lovely streak of minerality on the finish.

Marques de Caceres Rioja Blanco

Rioja, Spain

A hugely aromatic wine expressing intense flavours of apples and pears, with a light floral background. On the palate a freshness and vivacity comes through with an additional handful of lavish fruit.

Chapel Down Flint Dry

£19.50 per bottle

Kent, England

A medley of different varieties are blended and fermented together to reate this well-balanced wine. A dry intense palate with good weight and structure, this wine has flavours of pear, almond and some citrus.

Sistina Pecorino

£23.00 per bottle

Italy

Pale golden in colour, with a zesty and complex nose of acacia, sage and a mixture of citrus and exotic fruits. Bracingly crisp on the palate, the citrus theme continues with a nice dry finish.

Chablis, Jacques Dechames

£23.50 per bottle

Burgandy, France

This is a lively and fresh Chablis with clean citrus aromas. Crisp and fruity on the palate with a good steely character. The finish is long and lean, perfect for accompanying meaty white fish.

Gavi La Toledana Villa Lanata

Tuscany, Italy

Ripe peach and pears with hints of citrus and a slight honeyed edge held together by steely minerality and a fresh acidity

Sancerre "Les Baudrieres"

Loire Valley, France

Brightly coloured, fresh citrus with underlying minerality and suggestions of mussel shells, following on from the nose, it is refreshingly crisp with a well balanced finish.

Montagny Premier Cru, Cave de Buxy

Burgandy, France

A delicious, fresh Chardonnay which has been fermented and matured in stainless steel tanks to preserve the pure peach, pear and acacia aromas. Soft and rich on the palate.

Rose

Marques Calado Rosé

£12.50 per bottle £2.40 (125ml) £4.60 (250ml)

Cariñena DO, Spain

An intense pink wine with plenty of juicy berry fruit from a province northwest of Zaragoza that enjoys an excellent climate for viticulture. Strawberry and raspberry flavours are complimented by a creamy texture and crisp, refreshing acidity.

Torre Alta Pinot Grigio Rosé

£14.00 per bottle £2.55 (125ml) £4.90 (250ml)

Veneto, Italy

This wine demonstrates just why Pinot Grigio Rose is so popular at the moment. The elegant bouquet displays strawberry aromas in abundance and intense notes of acacia flowers. Dry, soft and well-balanced on the palate with a round and full bodied structure.

Cuvée de Richard Rose

£14.00 per bottle £2.55 (125ml) £4.90 (250ml)

France

A light and pale rosé from vineyards located between the villages of Cruzy and Argeliers in the Languedoc. Made primarily from Cinsault, with just a dash of Muscat in the blend. Bright and crisp, with very subtle strawberry fruit and a refreshing dryness. The small proportion of Muscat adds a dash of juicy grapeyness.

Chateau de Pampelonne, Cotes de Provence

France

Elegant but lively, salmon pink in the glass. The nose is a welcoming blend of strawberry and ripe tangerine notes, which carry through to a soft, peachy, yet refreshingly dry palate.

Sancerre Rose

Loire Valley, France

An attractive pale pink colour and aromas of red fruits supporting a rich, pure-fruited style with hints of vanilla and spices.

Red Wine

Marques Calado Tempranillo

£12.50 per bottle £2.40 (125ml) £4.60 (250ml)

Cariñena DO, Spain

Classic Tempranillo notes of dark cherry and blackcurrant are lifted by a hint of dried flowers and sweet spice. Superbly balanced, the fruits of the forest flavours are perfectly complemented by soft tannins.

Alto Plano Merlot

£13.50 per bottle £2.50 (125ml) £4.75 (250ml)

Central Valley, Chile

On the nose rich notes of plum and blackberries lifted by Chocolate and Mocha. Silky yet structured with concentrated fruit flavours.

Tin Roof Shiraz Cabernet

£14.00 per bottle £2.55 (125ml) £4.85 (250ml)

South Eastern, Australia

A soft fruity red with ripe berry fruit and gentle spicy flavours in a mid-weighted easy drinking style. The spicy Shiraz is lightened by the leafy Cabernet Sauvignon, and the two varieties are integrated and enriched by the judicious use of oak.

Robertson Winery Cabernet Sauvignon

Robertson, South Africa

A beautifully smooth full bodied red enhanced by rich mulberry, plum and cassis fruits and subtle soft tannins.

Bacaro Pino Noir

£13.50 per bottle

Italy

Bright and inviting ruby red. Fermentation and maturation without oak has preserved a fresh and intense bouquet of snappy strawberry and red apple fruit. Light tannins and taught acidity on the palate.

Aires Andinos Malbec

£14.50 per bottle

Mendoza, Argentina

A rich, ripe wine with plenty of smooth black fruit and warming hints of spice.

Zalze Pinotage

£16.50 per bottle

Western Cape, South Africa

This is a subtle and stylish wine with intense plum, mulberry and black fruit flavours.

La Croisade Reserve Grenache

£16.50 per bottle

France

This wine shows intense and complex aromas of jammy strawberry with spicy hints of blackcurrant on the nose. While on the palate it is smooth and velvety with a long and fruity aftertaste of cherry.

Otterbrook Mill Shiraz

£18.50 per bottle

South Eastern, Australia

A lovely, smooth wine showing notes of plum and dark, berry fruits with a delicate, spicy finish.

Rioja Gran Reserva, Gran Vendema

£22.50 per bottle

Rioja, Spain

Aged for 24 months in American oak and 4 years in bottle makes for a multi-dimensional wine, bursting with flavour. On the nose fruits of the forest mingle with a touch of spicy vanilla. The fruit on the palate is mature yet fresh with vanilla, toasty notes

Pinot Noir Domaine de Valmoissine, Louis Latour

Vin de Pays des Coteaux du Verdon, France

A medium-bodied Pinot Noir with subtle tannins. The grapes are sourced from the Vars region which is well placed to receive maximum sunshine throughout the summer but remains cool during spring time hence retaining a good crisp acidity.

Fleurie Flower Label, Georges Duboeuf

Beaujolais, France

The epitome of a Beaujolais Cru. Fruity, scented with an attractive silky texture and fresh raspberry fruit from Mr Beaujolais himself.

Barolo "Galarej" Fontanafredda

£30.00 per bottle

Piedmont, Italy

This is a robust, full bodied wine packed with structure and fully capable of withstanding the test of time. The bouquet is clean, full and intense, with typical Barolo characteristics of wild roses.

Champagne / Sparkling Wine

Prosecco Corte Alta NV

Italy

Delicate and aromatic with a light body and fine bubbles. Excellent as an aperitif or an accompaniment to canapés.

Prosecco di Conegliano Valdobbiadene Extra Dry

Italy

This fine, fruity Prosecco reveals hints of apples and pineapples. Ideal as an apéritif or to accompany light food.

De Telmont Grande Réserve
